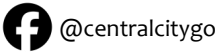
# Central City



The Central City Growth Organization (formerly known as Central City Mainstreet) is a volunteer-run and volunteer-powered organization focused on business and community development in the Central City area.

Originally formed in 2001, it has worked to preserve historic buildings and attract and support local businesses while building community through several yearly events.

In 2023, CCGO expanded its focus beyond the historical district, and now works to develop growth in all of Central City.



## CENTRAL CITY HISTORY

The historic river town of Central City was first settled shortly after the US government opened the Iowa Territory for settlers in 1838. This virgin territory

was regarded by many pioneers as the ideal opportunity to obtain fertile land for farming and to start new lives. The first pioneer cabin was built on the west side of the Wapsipinicon River in 1839. Thirty years later, enough settlers had come to the area and built permanent homes that a school was built.

Central City became an eastern Iowa transportation hub for these early settlers as it was located along the busy road from Marion to Manchester. A building boom ensued, but a major fire in 1889 burned down most of the wooden commercial structures in the downtown area. After this devastating fire, brick buildings were erected to minimize future fire risk. Most of the Victorian-era brick buildings still stand today, and the historic downtown commercial district is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

Come soak in the history as you visit our attractive downtown, shop the unique variety of shops & businesses, tour our historic museums and take in the scenic outdoors in one of our many recreational areas. There's plenty to do and see!

## PINICON RIDGE PARK

This 1018-acre park along the Wapsipinicon River has long been admired for its scenic

natural beauty. The hilly, heavily wooded area is divided by the river and is home to many species of wildlife. Beginning as a rural picnic ground in the 1960s, Pinicon Ridge Park has been developed into a modern recreation area and is a regional destination for many outdoor enthusiasts.

There are two entrances to the park, one each on the north and south sides of the Wapsipinicon River. Access to the south entrance is just off Highway 13 at 4732 Horseshoe Falls Rd. This side of the park is home to the lodges and shelters, the Alexander Wildlife Exhibit, watercraft in-park rentals, the landmark observation tower, hiking trails and the group campground complex. The north entrance is accessed from Hwy 13 by going west on Valley Farm Rd and turning south on Flying Squirrel Trail. You will find our main campgrounds and cabin complex on this side of the river, along with hiking trails and an off-leash area. The two sides of the park are connected by the Mary Lundby walking bridge that spans the river, and the 3-mile long Central City Trail paves the way for cyclists and hikers from the park to enter the town of Central City.

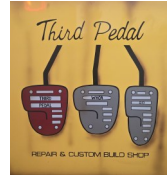
## WAKPICADA NATURAL AREA

Located on the south side of Central City and just east of the

Linn County Fairgrounds, this 352-acre natural area along the Wapsipinicon River was one of the first acquired by the Linn County Conservation Board as a wildlife management area. The area contains oxbow wetlands and several ponds that remain from the sand quarrying that took place with the four-lane construction of nearby IA Highway 13 in the 1970's.

Primitive camping is available at Wakpicada. The campground features 8 primitive campsites with fire rings. There is no electric or water service, but there are vault toilets. Wakpicada is open to equestrian camping and includes trails and boat access to the Wapsipinicon River.

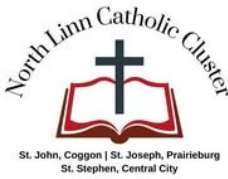

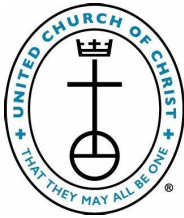

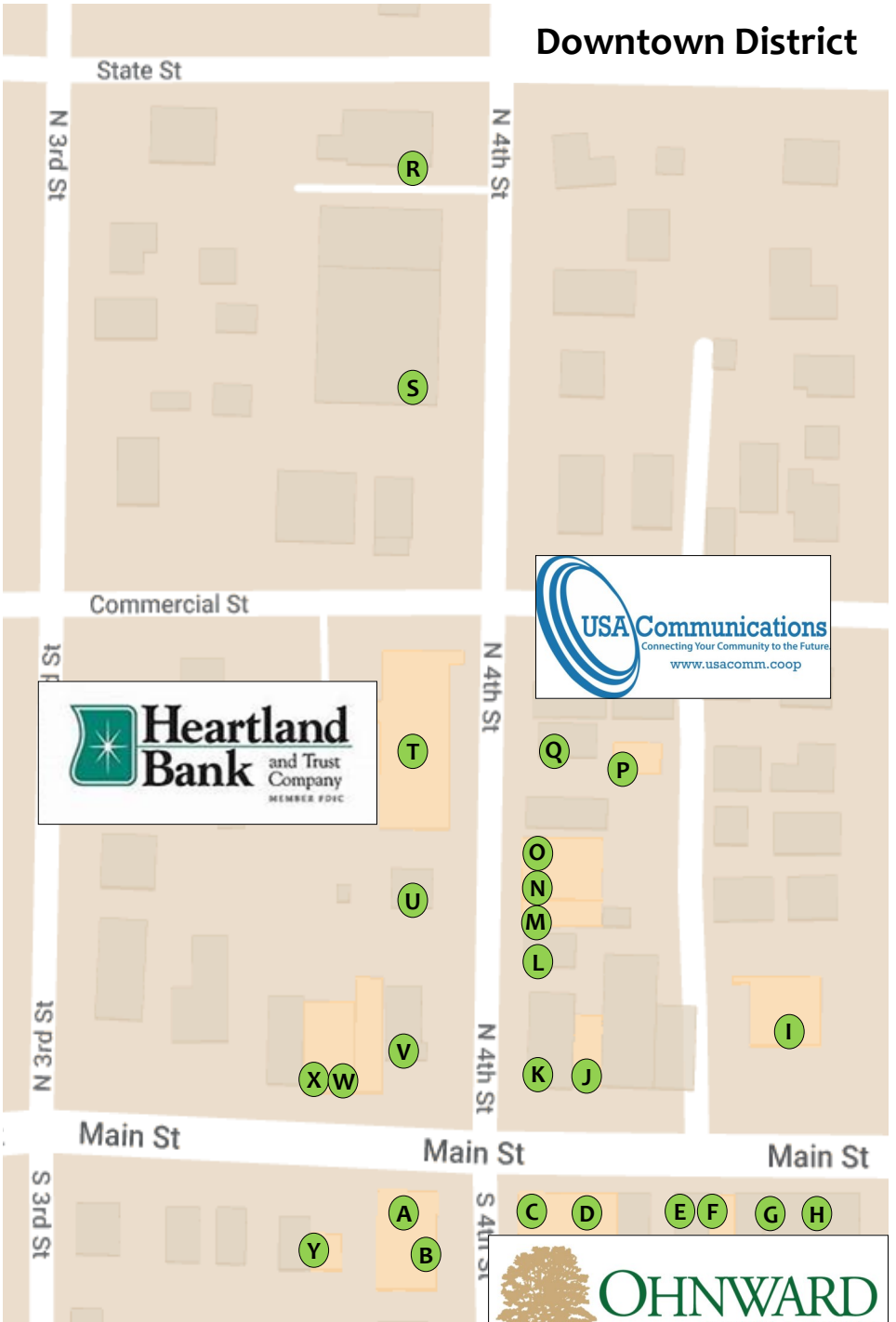
